Texas Educational Opportunity Grant (TEOG)/Texas Public Educational Grant (TPEG) Program Guidelines for 2023-2024

Program Purpose

The purpose of the Texas Educational Opportunity Grant (TEOG) Program is to provide grants of money to enable eligible students to attend two-year public institutions of higher education in Texas.

Student Eligibility Requirements

To receive an award through the TEOG Program, a student must:

- Be enrolled at least half-time as:
 - An entering undergraduate student in the first 30 hours (or its equivalent) of an Associate's Degree or certificate program at an eligible institution, or
 - An undergraduate student who previously received a TEOG award as an entering undergraduate student and has not been granted as associate's or baccalaureate degree
- Be classified by the institution as a Texas resident
- Show financial need (see award amount section below)
- Have applied for available financial assistance
- Have not been convicted of a felony
- Be registered with Selected Service, or be exempt
- Not be concurrently receiving a TEXAS Grant
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress (see SAP sections below)
