## 1. Go to [Financial Avenue](#)

- **New Users** : Get started by setting up your private account at FinancialAvenue.org. Once there, just click the “Sign Up Now” link and then provide your access code shown below. To create your account, you’ll need your LamarPA.edu email address and a password of your choosing.

**ACCESS CODE:** **lamarpa**




