GOAL TWO:

GRANT ACTIVITIES:

- Establish Excelencia Center, a welcoming space and hub for grant activities
- Embed Student Tutors in gateway courses
- Develop Summer Bridge for high school students
- Use co-requisite model in Developmental Courses
- Implement TSI Prep Course to increase student scores
