- DD214 (Member 4 copy) and DD Form 215 (if the DD Form 214 has been amended)
- Certificate of Eligibility
  - Apply online thru the GI Bill® website. If you have already applied but do not have your certificate yet, you may be able to print out a copy by logging into your E-Benefits page.
- Copy of original application for Benefits -
  - If you do not have this, you can fill out Form VBA 22-1990 (Veteran) or Form VBA 22-5490 (Dependent).
- Change in Place or Training (if transferring from another college)
  - Form VBA 22-1995 (Veteran) or Form VBA 22-5495 (Dependent)
- Official Military Transcripts (Required only if veteran is using their own benefits)
  - o Army/ Navy/ Marines/ Coast Guard: <https://jst.doded.mil/smart/signIn.do>
  - o Air Force: <https://www.credentials-inc.com/cgi-bin/DVCGITP.pgm?ALUMTRO012308>
- If the person using the benefits is not the veteran, One of the following:
  - o Marriage license (if student is spouse of veteran)
  - o Death certificate (if veteran is deceased)
  - o Birth certificate (if student is child of veteran)
- GPA Requirement Statement
- All previous colleges transcripts (if transferring from another college) – Turned into Admission and Records
- Semester schedule
- Make sure you have a major declared at LSCPA
